Course Regulations

1. Students will be subject to the course rules. In particular, they will be required to attend all meals, lessons and arranged activities and excursions.
2. Students will be responsible for keeping their own rooms tidy
3. All damages to property, equipment and rooms will be charged to the students and must be settled within 24 hours.
4. Consumption of alcohol by students is not permitted (note it is against the law in Britain for persons under the age of 18 to purchase alcohol). Alcohol must not be brought into the school premises by students of any age.
5. Controlled drug-taking or suspicion of controlled drug-taking of any kind will result in immediate dismissal
6. Smoking is not permitted in school premises at any time

Transfer supplements

The return UK airport transfer is included in the course fee for scheduled flight arrival / departure times between 10:00 - 16:00 (as published by the airlines) to/from London Heathrow and Gatwick Airport or major London Train station, on the advertised arrival and departure dates of the courses only. For students with scheduled flight arrivals / departures outside published days and hours or to/from different airports, there will be an airport transfer supplement per student for each transfer as follows:

Accommodation: types of rooms

Room allocation is subject to availability at the time of booking, booking early is highly recommended.

Dulwich College: single, twin and triple rooms all with en-suite bathrooms.
Caterham School: single, twin, triple and rooms for four (some rooms have en-suite bathrooms and others have shared facilities) – **en-suite rooms may be requested at the time of booking; a supplement of £50 per person per week applies.**

Wycombe Abbey: single standard rooms with shared bathroom facilities, Clarence boarding ages 8-17. Twin or quad en-suite accommodation in newly built Ruben or Pitt boarding, ages 10-17 – **en-suite rooms may be requested at the time of booking; a supplement of £125 per person per week applies.**
